Mindfulness of Money Tip: It's Tax Time!!! Are You Ready?

In my experience, Tax Season can bring up a lot of fear and anxiety. It used to be that way for me. Not only was I scared and anxious, I was unorganized and I always waited until the last minute. I would literally run around after work from place to place on April 15th, the usual national tax deadline, trying to get my personal income taxes filed! I did this for years! Eventually, I overcame my fear and changed my habits. Here are a few tips that helped me to get a grip on my fear and tax filing habits:

- 1. Get Organized Now
- 2. Decide on a Tax Professional or a Do-It-Yourself software.
- Set a Date and Schedule an Appointment before the (new) National Tax Deadline: May 17, 2021. See the Note below!
- 4. Get the support you need; ask questions. You can do it!





[Note: The U.S. federal government announced that it will extend the 2020tax filing due date from April 15 to May 17, 2021. California did the same for state income tax filing. Check for the state taxes deadline in the state where you live. Both the Internal Revenue Service and the California state tax agency said the extension will not apply to those making quarterly estimated tax payments on 2021 income that isn't subject to tax withholding. First-quarter payments will still be due April 15, 2021.]
